

THE LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (LDP) AT GLAD TIDINGS BIBLE COLLEGE

♦ WHO IS GTBC?

We are an evangelical interdenominational Bible College and have been in Uganda for over 50 years. We are a UNCHE- accredited tertiary college with a Pentecostal / Renewal emphasis.

♦ WHY STUDY LDP

The LDP is the basic essential ministerial award we offer in our curriculum. The LDP is designed for both ordained and lay leaders who may not have academic qualifications such as Ordinary and Advanced Level certificates. This short program is designed for mature born-again Christian students who are seeking to develop leadership skills tailored towards their ministry call.

♦ WHO QUALIFIES TO ENROLL IN THIS PROGRAM?

- **No academic qualifications are needed for this program.** However, the following are necessary:
- One must be able to perceive and speak Basic English as classes are conducted in the English language.
- One must be a mature born-again Christian from an evangelical church/ institution who is active in leadership in a local church.
- For all applicants, the pastor's recommendation is a **MUST**.

♦ HOW LONG DOES THE PROGRAM TAKE?

A student who qualifies for the award of a Certificate of attendance/participation in the LDP will normally take **ONE** year.

The academic year begins the second week of January and ends the second/third week of September. There are three 3-week sessions per term per year, covered in January-May-September during normal school holidays.

♦ DO I HAVE TO BE FULL TIME OR RESIDENTIAL?

Students can study full-time (housing currently available for males only) or part time and arrange their own schedule in accordance with their needs. Classes are conducted from 8:00am to 4:30pm

♦ ARE THERE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE?

The College **does not** offer scholarships for this program at this time. Students are encouraged to seek donors and sponsors from among their family, friends, churches and other contacts as the Lord may provide.

♦ WHAT MUST I DO TO GRADUATE?

- Earn at least 40 credits in coursework
- Pass all 40 credits of the required credits

♦ HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

1. For Full-Time students (Residential):

Registration:	UGX 15,000/= per term (Note: there are 3 terms per year.)
Tuition:	UGX 400,000/=
Books:	Will be loaned to student (or student may purchase books if so desired, at extra cost)
Food:	Included in tuition
Accommodation:	Included in tuition

2. For Part-Time students (i.e. Non-residential):

Registration:	UGX 15,000/= per term
Tuition:	UGX 300,000/=
Books:	varies from 7,000 up to UGX 12,000 per book
Food:	Available at extra cost
Accommodation:	Not available at GTBC
